I urged Senator Pankau and Senator Millner to sign Senate Bill 3530 and Representatives Reboletti and Ramey to sign House Bill 6096. Representative Coladipietro has already signed the House Bill. I encourage you to call or write your state legislators to sign onto these bills.
